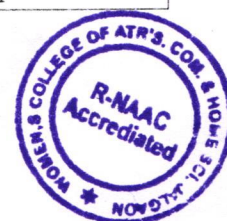

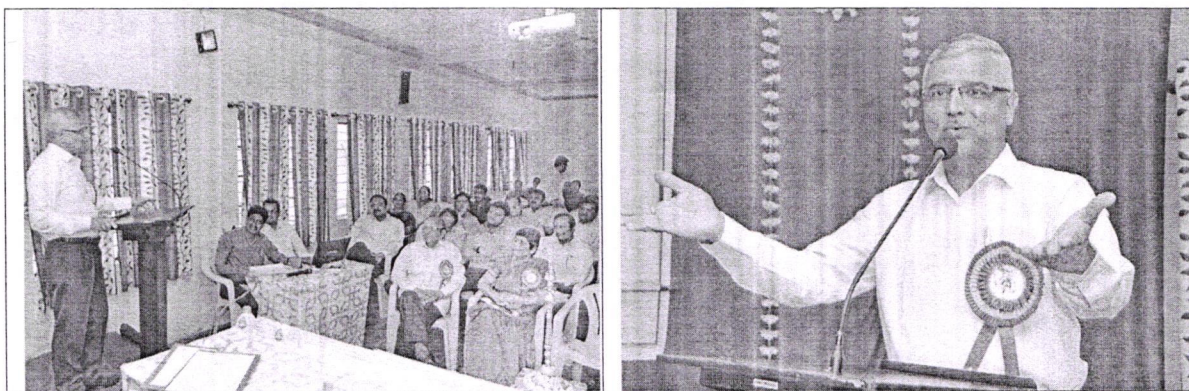

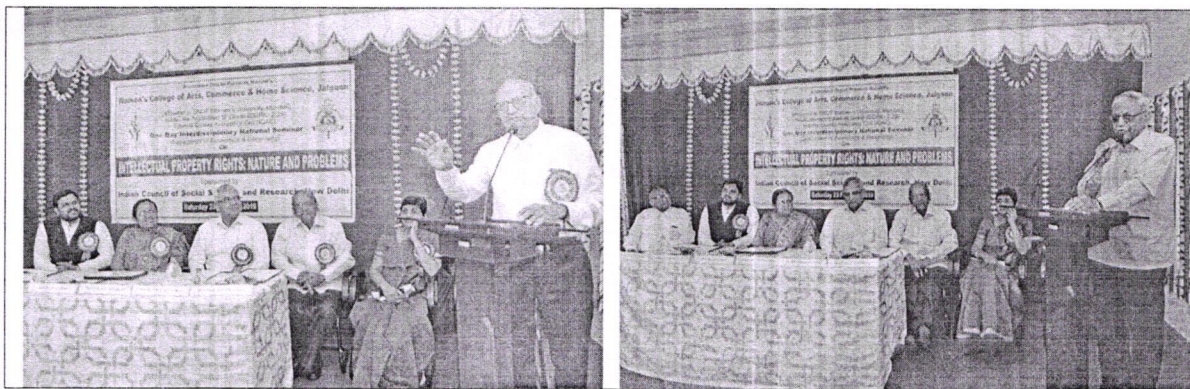


Dr. Vinayak Govilkar delivering a Key Note Address

In a Keynote address, Dr. Vinayak Govilkar expressed his views on various dimensions and potentials of Intellectual Property Rights with few cases.

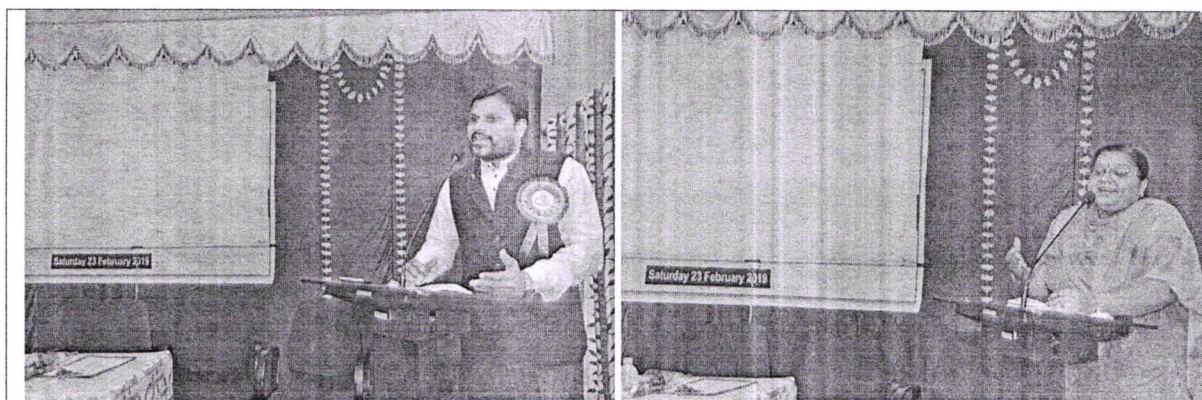

Session I



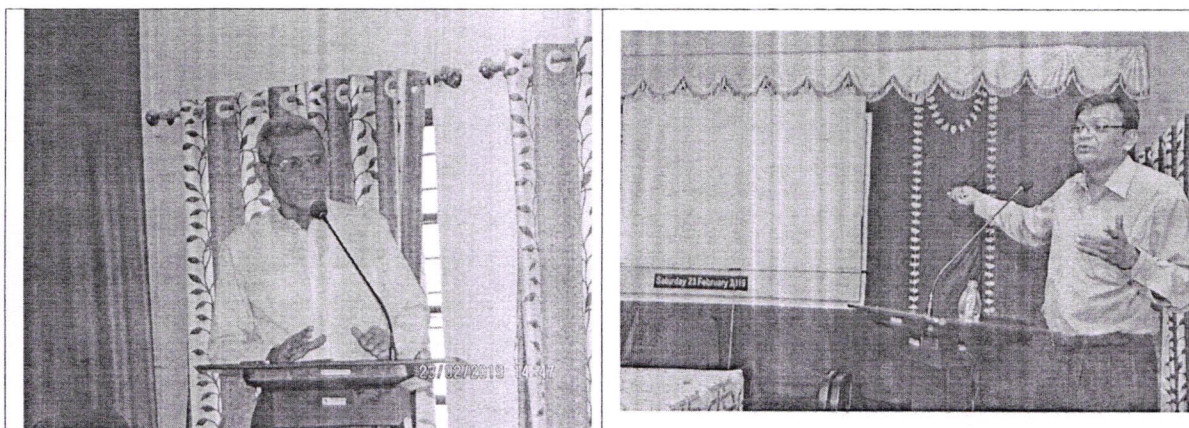

Valedictory Function




