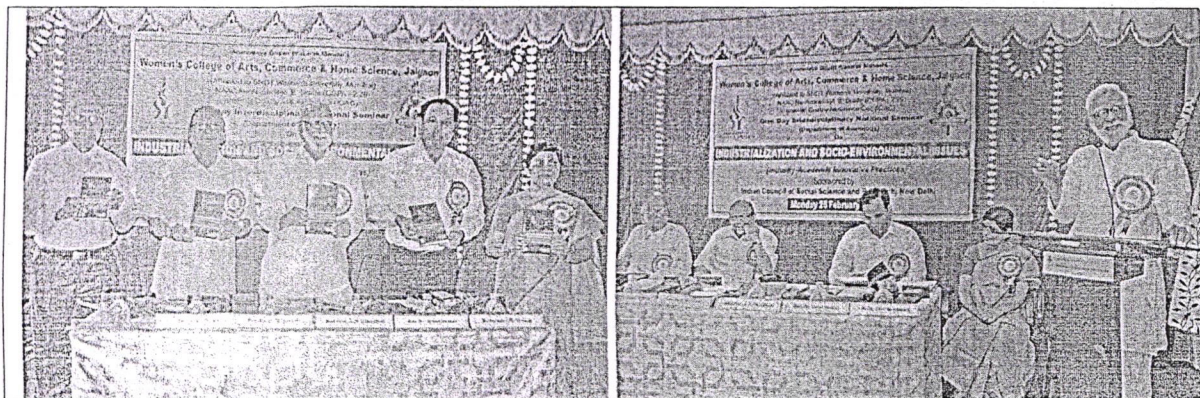
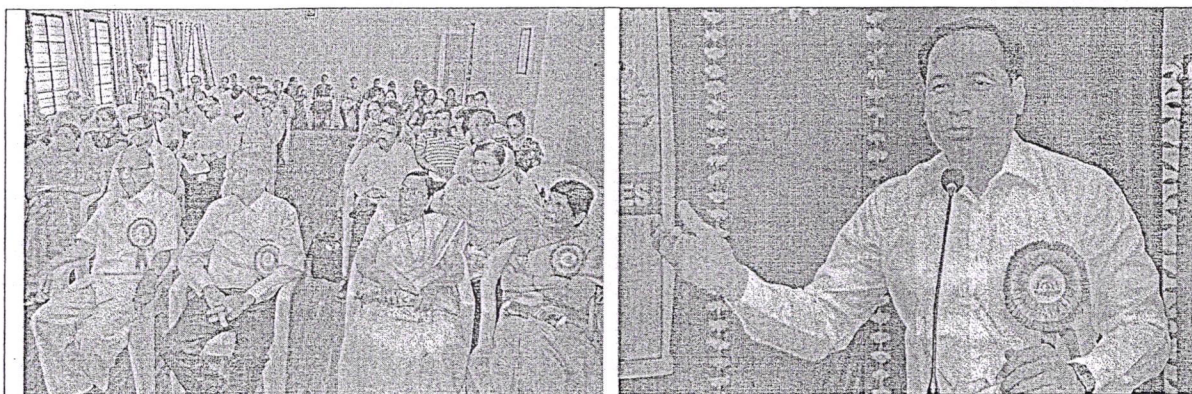

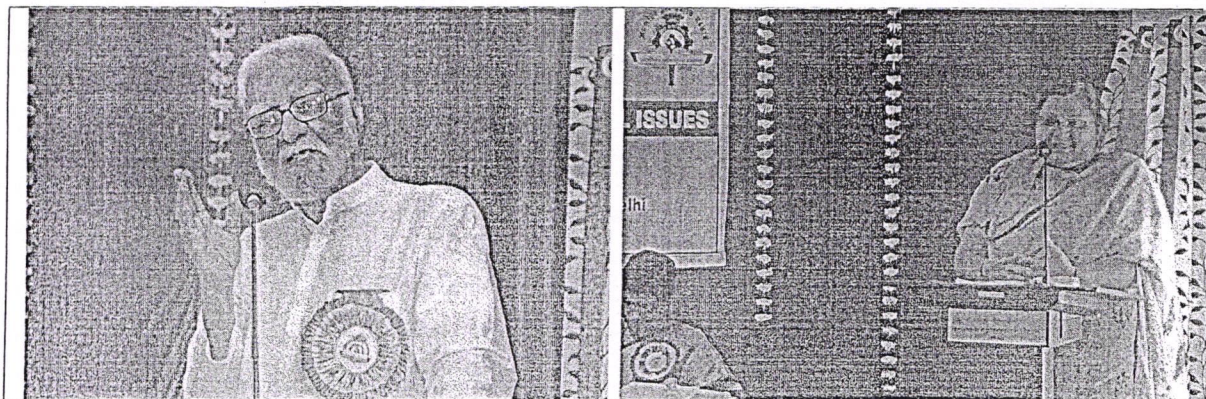
Dr. Abdul Shaban delivering a Key Note Address

industrialization damages environment. He provided data to substantiate his argument.

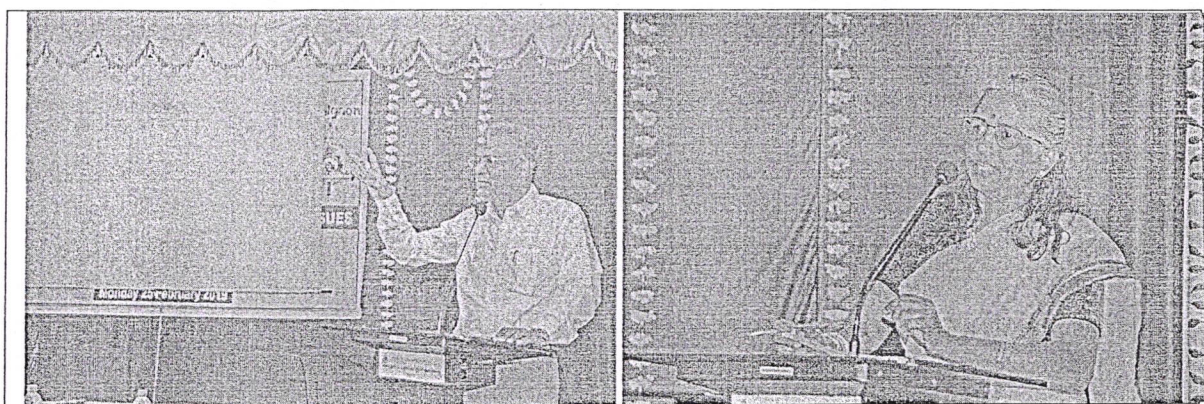

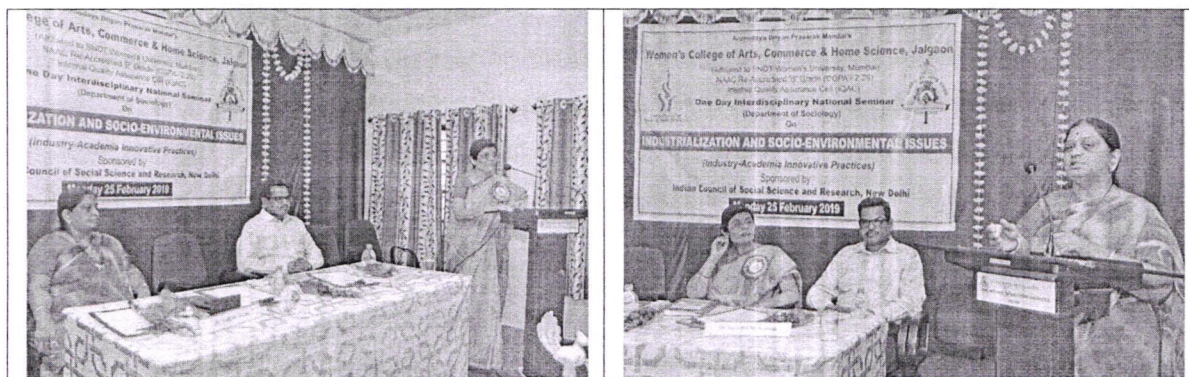
Session II








Valedictory Function
