RULES ABOUT EXAMINATION :

According to University Rules examination of BA I, II and III part is conducted in six semesters.

75% attendance is compulsory for filling the exam form.

Each paper of BA I, II and III part will have 25 internal marks where as 75 external marks and total marks are 100. (25 marks are divided into Test/Project/Home Assignment/Group discussion/Behaviour etc.)

For passing in internal exam 9 marks out of 25 marks, & in external exam 26 marks out of 75 marks are necessary.

RULES ABOUT ATKT :

The students failed in semester I will automatically be admitted in semester II.

Students must pass at least 7 papers out of 12 papers of I and II second semesters to appear for semester III.

The students passed or failed in III semester will get admission in semester IV automatically.

Students should pass the semester I & II to appear for semester V. whereas she should be passed at least 7 papers out of 12 papers of III & IV semesters.

The marks obtained in internal exam will be valid for next five years.

A student can have 1 % marks, out of the total marks of the semester, as grace marks. This grace marks may be given for one subject or divided more than one subject. A student may have 0.5% marks out of total marks of the semester as grace marks to obtain First Class.

It is obligatory for all the students to read all the notices displayed on the board to know the different decisions of the university and the Govt.

REGULATIONS OF FEE REMITTANCE :

First Installment : Till 15th August

Second Installment : Till 15th September

Examination fees will be separate besides University Eligibility Fees Rs. 300/- for fresh admission along with the Eligibility Form.

If a student fails to pay the fees according to the schedule, he will be fined. A student should pay his fees only in the office.
