She elaborated her topic with the help of many examples and created awareness about the rughts of women. In the last part of session she answered the questions asked by participants.

In the second session Prof. Ganpat Dhumale talked on the topic, 'Indian Constitution and Women's Rights'. Prof. Dhumale being an assistant professor in Law, he could handle the topic very well. He explained number of articles in Indian Constitution for Women's Empowerment and gave examples related to fundamental rights, directive principals and political reservation for women in India. He appealed to women to be aware of their rights. He is of the opinion that a large portion of women is unaware about their basic, human and special rights, facilities and concession given by Indian Constitution and Government. In the last part of the session he answered the question raised by some participants.

Dr. Dimpal Patil introduced both the honorable guests and Dr. Satish Jadhav, Co-ordinator NAAC-IQAC compeered the entire webinar.
