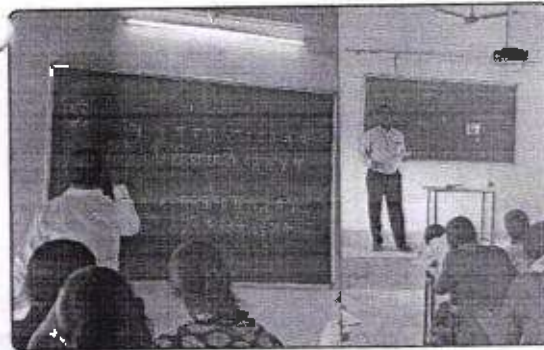
of thanks for the workshop.

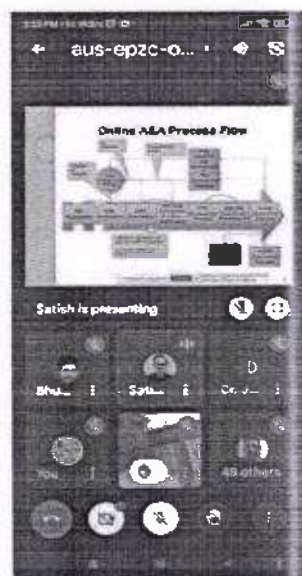
